Elementary schools	The school sends new timetables. On 7.5. + 8.5.2020 only class 4
Förderschulen (school for mentally challenged children). Not KME+GE	The school sends new school schedules. On May 7th and May 8th, 2020 only class 4

From 11.05.2020 - 26.05.2020

The Schools send new school schedules.

In sek 1 (grades 5-9), all-day schools are only available in the morning.

High school+Comprehensive school (Gymnasium+Gesamtschule)	Abitur exams from may 12th till 26.may 2020 Q1
Secondary modern school (Hauptschule) Secondary School (Sekundarschule) Junior high school (Realschule)	Classes 10 1 or 2 classes everyday.

Elementary School (Grundschule)	The school is sending new timetables for grades 1-4. A different class comes to school every day.
Förderschule (School for mentally challenged children) Not KME+GE	The school send new timetables. Lessons for all classes at different days

From 26.05.2020 - 26.05.2020

Schools are sending new timetables.

In SEK 1 (grades 5-9), all-day schools only teach in the morning.

SUMMER HOLIDAYS 29.06-11.08.2020

→ **ATTENTION:** These children and adolescents do NOT have to go to school.

Please inform the school management (letter, mail) from:

Family history - risk to health

- Pupils have pre-existing conditions.
- A person in the family has previous illnesses.

You give a medical **CERTIFICATE** from a doctor to the school

Dangerous previous illnesses in the family with COVID19:

Heart disease, high blood pressure, lung disease (COPD, bronchial asthma), chronic liver disease, kidney disease, oncological diseases, diabetes mellitus, weakened immune system)

→ Emergency care

There is special support at school for pupils in grades 1-6. You must apply for emergency care.

Have a right to emergency care:

- o Parents work in systemically relevant professions
- o Single parents who are working or taking an exam
- o Families supervised by the youth welfare office (no application necessary, the youth welfare office decides)
- o Children with special needs.
